Content Licensing Agreement and Terms of Use for "The Jewish Relation To Cannabis"

THIS COPYRIGHT LICENSE AGREEMENT (the "License Agreement") was dated on _	of

BETWEEN: Lissa Skitolsky, Ph.D. ("Licensor") AND ("Licensee")	

BACKGROUND:

The Licensor wants to license use of the digital content "The Jewish Relation To Cannabis" (the "Licensed Content") to the Licensee and the Licensee purchased the license under the terms and conditions stated below.

IN CONSIDERATION OF the provisions contained in this License Agreement and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

LICENSE

- 1. Under this Agreement the Licensor grants to the Licensee a non-exclusive and non-transferable license to use the digital Content contained in "The Jewish Relation to Cannabis" in PDF or PPX form for scholarly and educational use.
- 2. Title, copyright, intellectual property rights and distribution rights of the digital content remain exclusively with the Licensor. This Agreement constitutes a license for use only and is not in any way a transfer of ownership rights to the intellectual property.
- 3. The rights and obligations of this Agreement are rights granted to the Licensee only. The Licensee may not transfer or assign any of the rights or obligations granted under this Agreement to any other person or legal entity.
- 4. Failure to comply with any of the terms under the License section will be considered a material breach of this Agreement.

LICENSE FEE

5. The purchase price of \$80.00 in CAD (plus 15% sales tax) paid by the Licensee will constitute the entire license fee and is the full consideration for this Agreement.



EDUCATIONAL USE

- 6. <u>SCHOLARLY SHARING</u> Authorized Users may provide, by paper or electronic means, a single copy of the Licensed Content to a colleague who is not an Authorized User for Scholarly and Educational Use.
- 7. ACADEMIC RESEARCH AND TEACHING Members and Authorized users may:
- (a.) incorporate parts of the Licensed Content in printed or electronic form in assignments, portfolios, theses, dissertations, teaching, conference presentations, and lectures, with appropriate credit.
- (b.) make full use, with appropriate credit, of the Licensed Content in research and publications for personal, scholarly, educational, or professional use.
- (c.) For the avoidance of doubt, none of these activities may be undertaken for Commercial Use.
- 8. <u>COURSE PACKS</u>, <u>ELECTRONIC RESERVE</u>, <u>& ELECTRONIC LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS</u>
 Members and Authorized Users may incorporate parts of the Licensed Content in printed and electronic Course Packs and Electronic Reserve collections for the use of Authorized Users in the course of instruction at a Member, and/or in Electronic Learning Environments hosted on a Secure Network, but not for Commercial Use. Each such item shall carry appropriate acknowledgement of the source.
- 9.<u>CLASSROOM HANDOUTS</u> Members and Authorized Users may distribute single copies of individual articles or items of the Licensed Content in print or electronic form to Authorized Users.
- 10. <u>TRAINING AND MARKETING MATERIALS</u> Members and Authorized Users may display, download or print the Licensed Content for the purposes of internal marketing and for training Authorized Users.

PROHIBITED USES

- 11. <u>REMOVAL OF COPYRIGHT OR TRADEMARK</u> Licensee, Members, and Authorized Users shall not remove, obscure or alter in any way the authors' names or the Licensor's copyright notices, logos or other means of identification or disclaimers as they appear in the Licensed Content.
- 12. <u>PUBLIC REDISTRIBUTION</u> Except as permitted, Licensee, Members, and Authorized Users may not re-distribute, reproduce or transmit to anyone other than Authorized Users the whole or any part of the Licensed Content by any means including electronic (e.g. via email), nor post it on publicly-accessible web sites or networks.
- 13. <u>COMMERCIAL USE</u> Licensee, Members, and Authorized Users may not use all or any part of the Licensed Content for any Commercial Use without Licensor's explicit permission.



LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

- 14. The digital content is provided by the Licensor and accepted by the Licensee "as is". Liability of the Licensor will be limited to a maximum of the original purchase price of the content.
- 15. The Licensor will not be liable for any general, special, incidental or consequential damages including, but not limited to, loss of production, loss of profits, loss of revenue, loss of data, or any other business or economic disadvantage suffered by the Licensee arising out of the use or failure to use the content. The Licensor makes no warranty expressed or implied regarding the fitness of the content for a particular purpose.

WARRANTS AND REPRESENTATIONS

16. The Licensor warrants and represents that it is the copyright holder of "The Jewish Relation to Cannabis." The Licensor warrants and represents that granting the license to use this content for educational purposes is not in violation of any other agreement, copyright or applicable statute.

ACCEPTANCE

17. All terms, conditions and obligations of this Agreement will be deemed to be accepted by the Licensee ("Acceptance") upon receipt of this Agreement for the purchase of the Licensed Content on cannabisjew.com.

TERM

18. The term of this Agreement will begin on Acceptance and is perpetual.

TERMINATION

20. The Parties to this Agreement submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of Nova Scotia for the enforcement of this Agreement or any arbitration award or decision arising from this Agreement.
